



REQUIREMENTS FOR THE IMPORTATION OF VEHICLES

- The **owner** must have lived outside of Argentina for **more than 2 years**, and must be able to prove it by means of a **Residence Certificate**.
- The vehicle must have been under the owner's name for **3 months prior to his/her arrival** to Argentina.
- The vehicle's title must be **endorsed at the argentine consulate** in origin and translated to spanish by a **public translator** in Argentina.
- The owner cannot have imported a vehicle in the **last 7 years**.
- The owner can **only** import one car and/or one motorbike.

In case of the vehicle being delivered with a **temporary admission of transit**, its **custom clearance must be finished by the client immediately after delivery in the corresponding jurisdiction**. If any questions, ask you Elishar Moving Agent.

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE TAX EXEMPTION ON THE IMPORTATION OF VEHICLES

CARS

The car must have a value of less than USD 13,500. Argentine Customs determines its value based on the most commonly used used-car sales websites in the country of origin of the move.

If the owner comes from the United States, the Argentine Customs will determine the value of the car according to the Kelley Blue Book.

MOTORBIKES

Are **not exempt** of paying taxes.
